1. A meeting of the Departmental Research Committee was held in order to examine three Ph D synopses which had been submitted to the Department.



Minutes of the Meeting of the Departmental Research Committee held in the office of the Head, Department of English on 26-8-2017.

The meeting commenced with a note of welcome by the Head to all the members who also congratulated Dr Javed and Dr Shabir from the South Campus for their appointment as research guides.

The meeting had been called in order to discuss the modalities for the Integrated Research Programme (2017) for which the Dept has already received a list of selected candidates. A total of 25 students had been selected, out of which 14 have completed admission formalities.

A total number of 11 (eleven) candidates interacted with the members. The candidates were asked about their preferred area of research as well as their preference for research guides. The members had a preliminary exchange of ideas with the candidates in order to assess the potential/viability of the proposed programme. After a thorough discussion, the following decisions were taken:

1. Ishaq Ahmed Wani and Shahnawaz Muntazir (FIP and Part-time In-Service respectively) would get a period of three months in order to obtain the required permission from their respective parent departments. However, to save time, they would be required to submit their synopsis by 1st October, 2017.

2. The rest of the candidates would be required to contact their supervisors (allotted in course of the meeting) and initiate their preliminary work for the research programme.

3. Class Work for the Integrated Research Programme would start by 20th October.

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Minutes of the meeting of DRC held in the office chamber of the Chairperson DRC on 12-06-2017.

The agenda of the meeting was to finalize the selection list of candidates for Ph D programme for the academic session 2017. The Chairperson apprised the committee of the list of candidates forwarded for the said programme by the office of the Dean, School of Arts, Languages and Literatures. The committee was also apprised of the latest notifications regarding the final selection of candidates for the said research programme by the office of the Dean Research.

The committee resolved that since a large number of candidates (46 to be precise) are desirous to pursue their Ph D programme in English therefore teachers in the department, Main Campus will take scholars over and above the stipulated number allotted to them as per the University statutes. It was decided that the slot occupied by a scholar who has completed his/her residency period shall be treated as a vacancy. As such the committee identified some 25 vacancies with teachers from the Main Campus, North Campus and South Campus. Out of these 25 vacancies, 5 seats were allotted to in-service candidates on the basis of 25% share of the total number of vacancies. Taking cognizance of the statutes of 24-09-2014, the committee made the final selection of the in-service candidates on the basis of their PG percentage and the length of their service in their respective institutions. The committee also decided to have a waiting list of 03 in-service candidates.

The committee allotted the remaining 20 seats to NET/SET candidates on the basis of their PG merit. It was also decided that 03 NET/SET candidates and 02 candidates who have qualified the Entrance Examination for Ph d (2017) be wait listed according to their PG merit

Minutes of the Departmental Committee Meeting/Departmental Research Committee Meeting held in the office of the Head, Department of English, University of Kashmir at 2.30 pm. 3-8-2012.

The meeting began with a note of welcome from the Head to the members present. The head informed the members that a total of three items were to be discussed.

1. The first item on the agenda was regarding the utilization of the Self-financed quota allotted to the Department. The share due to the department is 40% of the total amount which when calculated comes to Rs 4,42,000/- . The following items were then identified for purchasing:
 - a. AC for the Office of the Head: 1
 - b. AC for the office : 2
 - c. The total amount required for three AC's: Rupees three lakh. Rs 3,00,000.
2. Keeping in view the recent pilfering of photographs from the corridors as well as the damage to the newly installed water filtering dispenser, it was decided that a CCTV camera would be installed in the passage leading to the library and the passage outside the classrooms. The total expenditure would be an amount of eighty thousand rupees 80,000.
However, taking note of the fact that many of the faculty members wanted repairing of their computer systems, a thorough check of all systems would be made by calling professional help from the IT department and if the need arises , the Department would forgo the CCTV camera and instead procure new computer systems for the faculty members.

The next item to be taken up for discussion was for the members of the Departmental Research Committee.

1. The Head informed the members that the Department had received applications from Dr Qazi Khursheed, and Dr Amin Parray, both Assistant Professors at North campus, Baramulla for their nomination/ appointment as Research guides/ Co-Supervisors in the Department of English, University of Kashmir.
The members were of the opinion that the aforementioned faculty neither has the mandatory Post-graduate teaching experience nor is there any need /scope for co-supervision in the research areas offered by the Department as the faculty is adequately competent to undertake research supervision. Co-supervision could have been an option if the research is of an inter-disciplinary nature and inter-departmental assistance could then be sought.
In this case, co-supervision from the same discipline would only prove redundant/superfluous.
2. The next item was regarding the proper verification/ authenticity of the Degree certificates submitted by students outside J&K desirous of getting admission in M Phil and Ph D courses offered by the Department.

In this connection, the Academic section had laid down new parameters for ascertaining eligibility of universities/institutions.

- a. The University must have UGC recognition.
- b. The candidate should have the minimum required eligibility i.e 55% at the Masters level.
- c. The duration of the courses at the undergraduate level- whether the student has put in the required no of years after the 10 plus two level.
- d. The mode of pursuit of the degree (whether part-time or regular) is to be ascertained.
- e. Parity in the syllabus (between the parent university and the University of Kashmir).









