Minutes of the meeting of Board of Undergraduate Studies in English held on 27-06-2023.

The meeting began with a note of welcome to the members with the Head, who was chairing the meeting, thanking them for attending the meeting. She briefed them about the agenda of the board meeting which was to frame syllabi for semesters 3-8 for General English, English Literature, and Functional English for the Four-year undergraduate programme under NEP (2020) implemented by the University of Kashmir w.e.f. August 2022. The members were also apprised that syllabi for Semesters 1 and 2 for the same courses had already been framed by the BOUGS in July 2022. The members present were:

Before deliberating on each course, the convener informed the members that keeping in view the commencement of the new academic session, syllabuses for semesters 3 and 4 along with course titles for all semesters have to be sent to the Academic section at the earliest.

1. English Literature

The convener informed the members that this would feature as a Major/Minor course and would include 6 credits in semester 3(4+2). She further explained to the members the new course structure that was to be followed. Semester 4 would have Course type 1 of 4 credits (3+1), Course Type 2 of 6 credits (4+2) and Course Type 3 of 6 credits (4+2). This scheme would continue till the 8th semester. Students opting for Honors with research would have a written dissertation of 12 credits instead of Course type 2 and 3 in Semester 8. After a thorough and detailed discussion, syllabi for all the semesters were framed. (Syllabus for semesters 3 and 4 appended)

2. General English

The convener informed the members that this would feature as a Minor course and would include 6 credits (4+2) in semester 3 and 4 credits (3+1) from semesters 4-8. After a thorough discussion, it was decided to continue with the English text book series already in use. *English 2* and *English 3*, prepared by the Dept of English, University of Kashmir and published by Cambridge University Press, New Delhi were unanimously recommended for Semesters 3 and 4 respectively. (Syllabus for semesters 3 and 4 appended)

3. Functional English

The convener informed the members that this would feature as a minor course and would include 6 credits (4+2) in semester 3 and 4 credits (3+1) from semesters 4-8. After a careful examination of the existing syllabus and a thorough and detailed discussion, syllabi for all the semesters were framed. (Syllabus for semesters 3 and 4 appended)

The meeting ended with the convener thanking the members for their active participation and involvement. She assured the members that the department would be open to suggestions and feedback.




